Update from e-safetyadviser.com:

Since it first came out a few years ago, Character.Al (and other Al chatbots) have been a significant safeguarding concern for many highly inappropriate chats, advice, and even instrumental in some really tragic outcomes, with some Al companies, including Character.Al facing lawsuits.

In the case of Character.AI, as of 25th November under 18's will no longer be able to use the chat function, they will only be able to generate content such as videos rather than talk to the characters. This is a welcome move, and a guardrail that should have existed from the very start, but it's one of many chatbots that are out there (just look on the Apple App store and Google Play to see how sexualised many of them are). In my personal experience speaking with younger children, I know that children from around the age of 7 are using chatbots for a variety of reasons, one of the main (concerning) ones being loneliness.

A compulsory full cast read-through will be held on Tuesday 25th November from 3:00pm – 5:30pm, and rehearsals will begin in earnest on Tuesday 2nd December. Please note that not all students will be required at every rehearsal. The full rehearsal schedule is displayed weekly on the Drama noticeboard for anyone wishing to check the commitment involved. While putting on a production is hugely rewarding, it is also demanding, and some roles, such as Alice, will require a particularly high level of dedication. Students are encouraged to consider their availability carefully before auditioning.

code stlaurence. Please note: this offer applies to online orders only and cannot be redeemed in store. Students will need a copy of the script by 25th November for the read through.


