

6th Form Dress Code

6th Form students are expected to dress appropriately for the task of learning and membership of St Laurence School. A smart appearance is therefore expected of all students in the St Laurence community.

Staff are entitled to engage with students over their appearance and exercise judgement over what is suitable within the framework of this dress code. The demands of religious beliefs are considered and taken into account.

The dress code for 6th Form students is as follows:

- Footwear in good condition and suitable for the context of St Laurence School. No flip flops, high heels, sandals, crocs etc
- Conventional jewellery/earrings with a maximum of one facial piercing
- Clothes of suitable style with no extremes of fashion
- Appropriate taste/decency: no crop tops, strappy tops, eg spaghetti straps or ripped clothes
- Dresses/skirts must be to a mid-thigh length
- No beach-wear, tracksuit bottoms or leggings
- Tailored Shorts may be worn (No sports shorts/football style shorts)
- Reasonable hairstyle with no extremes of fashion or headwear

If students are in any doubt about what is acceptable they should check with a member of the 6th Form Team <u>before</u> they choose to invest in it, and/or wear it.
